Key Achievements and Experiences

International Web Design - Vicor Europe

September 2008 / January 2010

For 12 months I have designed email and landing pages for Vicor Europe. Taking into account each design needed to be developed for 4 different languages. I consequently needed to allow extra space for longer words and phrases common in these languages. Colour changes also needed to be taken into account as various colours are interpreted differently depending on the country. I regularly view design blogs and forums to keep up to date with latest trends and practises which I use as influences in my work.

Email Design and Development – British Telecom

October 2007 / January 2010

For two years I designed email campaigns for British Telecom. Working with their strong brand identity I was able to use my knowledge of design and in particular the various limitations of email clients to design campaigns which not only appeared attractive but also carried distinctive references to the “character” of the brand defined in its core values.

Interactive Wireframes and Design - Sainsbury's Calais

January 2010 / April 2010

To enable the management and employees to understand the user experience of their website I created wireframes using Azure. User experience is a key element to all the websites I design as I believe a disappointing user experience will reflect badly on a company's brand. Using my research and knowledge of user interaction, the wireframe prototype became a fully functional website with navigation, links and text areas. Previously Altaire designed straight away without understanding the importance of the user experience so this recommendation has enabled us to run more efficiently and effectively. On this project I was involved throughout all stages of web creation. This involved preliminary conversations involving management at Sainsbury's, designing of all pages and the implementing of front end code.

Illustrator and Image Manipulation – Photography

Photographic re-touching of digital photographs and error correction of old/damaged prints using my extensive knowledge of Adobe Photoshop.
